### Information according to Article 33 (1) REACH-Regulation

Dear Sir or Madam,

On 1 June 2007, the Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 for Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) entered into force.

In accordance with Article 33 (1) of the REACH-Regulation, your company, as a supplier of articles or complex objects, consisting of several articles, is obliged to provide us with sufficient information, provided that these articles contain substances of very high concern (SVHC) with a concentration of more than 0.1 % weight by weight. A list of these substances can be found on the candidate list of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA):

Since there is no legal obligation to provide information for your company, as long as the articles delivered to us do not contain a listed SVHC, we will continue to assume, that for articles delivered without information pursuant to Article 33 (1) of the REACH Regulation, do not contain such SVHC.
